After graduation, Dr. Rainer began his career as an active service dentist in the Army treating only adults, ages 18 and up. He chuckled as he recalled one patient come back for his first dental visit after more than a year of social distancing due to the pandemic. When

so many other things in the boy's world had changed, the 9-year-old was astonished to see he still had the same dentist who had been treating him since he was little.

"He said, 'It's 2021 and you're still working here?" Dr. Rainer said. "He didn't understand why I hadn't changed my workplace."
